The Local Plan Issues and Options consultation is now live. As many people as possible are urged

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to respond. The Plan proposes above the Government target of 27% with 8900 houses over fifteen years. A protest is taking place at Castle House and various letters had been sent. It was **RESOLVED** that DH would resubmit the bid and note on the Asset of Community Value request in relation to the restriction of public access to Keele Golf Course. The media campaign by SOGS continues and KPC and SOGS are working together. A meeting is arranged with Simon Tagg for 23 November 2021.

GB had drafted an executive summary of the Issues and Options document giving a brief response to each of the critical questions. It was **RESOLVED** to circulate this to the Bulletin list.

It had been **RESOLVED** for KPC not to meet in December 2021 however there would be meetings to discuss the responses to The Local Plan.

# **Renovation of Statues**

Staffordshire County Council modified the contract but omitted the second site at Station Road and claimed they did not own the statue or land it stood on. Fortunately, they were very responsive when we pointed out their error and the contract has gone back to Legal for a further rewrite.

# **Platinum Tree Planting**

We had another site meeting with Rob Steele at the Station Road site and he is now facilitating the necessary admin to allow the planting to take place.

# **Borough Plan**

The consultation is now live, having opened on the 1<sup>st</sup> November. Parish Councillors and residents are encouraged to register and submit their

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personal comments. I am in the process of drafting a set of comments from Keele. There will be a special Parish Council meeting to finalise our comments in the next few weeks. The window for submitting comments closes 13thDecember at 5 p.m. The link to the consultation portal is:

In addition, members of the Keele and Silverdale Parish Councils and Save Our Green Space attended the consultation session in Silverdale on 4<sup>th</sup> November. We learned that it was possible to submit comments by post to:

Responders need to give their name and address and put the question numbers they are responding to next to their responses. If you choose to respond by post, you should receive a written confirmation of receipt. All valid comments will then be manually transcribed

I have attached a copy of the Issues and Options document with the circulation of this mail. I also hope to provide some support documents including a 'key points' summary, in the near future and in good time to support those who wish to comment.

I have also corresponded with Borough Planning about the accessibility of the process to those who have impaired vision or other issues. They acknowledged that, at launch, the site was not fully accessible as legally required. They are working on ensuring the pdf of the document is readable by software and other measures. I continue to pursue this issue and will let you know of developments.
