Keele Parish Council has developed a draft Neighbourhood Plan, which aims to set out a vision and planning policies for Keele Parish for the coming years up to 2035.

The draft Neighbourhood Plan includes policies which will guide the future development of the Parish. The Plan seeks to positively address climate change, support the rural economy, protect the rural and natural landscape, encourage heritage-led regeneration, and support housing to meet local need. The draft Neighbourhood Plan will be independently examined and will then be subject to a public referendum. If successful the Plan will become statutory policy to inform planning decisions.

This public consultation is your chance to have your say on Keele's draft Neighbourhood Plan. The consultation runs from **Tuesday 17th February at 12:00 noon to Tuesday 31st March 2026 at 12:00 noon.**
